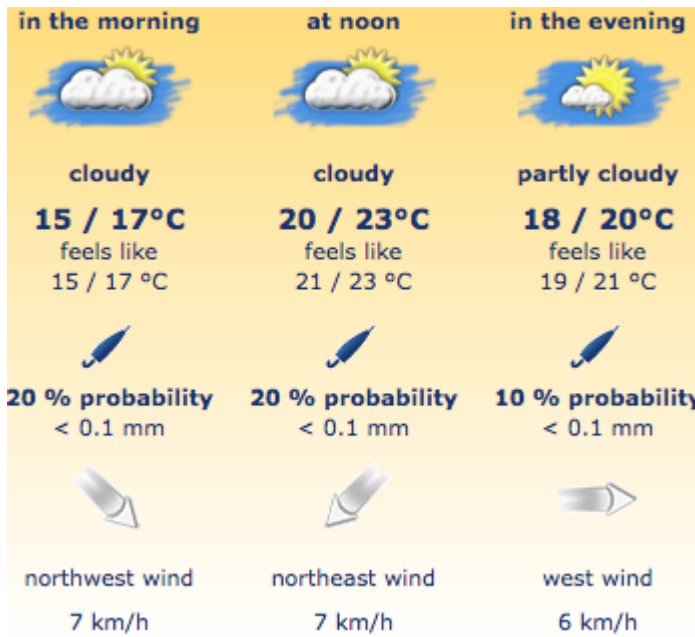

The Opening Reception will take place at a beach bar right in the heart of Vienna: **Strandbar Herrmann** (Im Herrmannpark 1). The bar can be reached from the conference location by a five minute walk. If you plan to come from another location, you can get there by public transportation either via subway line U4 (station Schwedenplatz, exit Urania), or via tramway line 1 or line 2 (station Julius-Raab-Platz).



The bar is named after Emanuel Herrmann, the forgotten inventor of the good old post card. In 1869, the professor of Vienna University of Technology, proposed a new way of communication within a newspaper article: a card without envelope, sent via post service. As the post card was rolled out half the price of a regular letter, it became very popular within the Austrian monarchy, and finally around the whole globe.
